# HASKELL CITY COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES DECEMBER 9, 2013

The regular meeting of the Haskell City Council was held at 7:00 p.m. at the Haskell City Hall.

Mayor Arey called the meeting to order.

**ROLL CALL:** Aldermen present were Ronnie Ballard, Rose Marie Wilkinson, Terry Babbs, Raymond Lobbs, Ed Simmons, Gary Vice, Allen Nash, and Hal Baker. Others present were Mayor Jeff Arey, Recorder Janie Lyman, Lt. Mike Hardester, Fire Chief Brian Cotten, and Water/Sewer Supt. Robert Burson.

Mayor Arey led the Pledge of Allegiance, and Rose Marie Wilkinson gave the prayer.

Mayor Arey declared a quorum present, and called for the reading of the minutes of the November 18<sup>th</sup> meeting. Hal Baker made the motion, seconded by Rose Marie Wilkinson, to accept the minutes as presented. The motion passed unanimously by yea vote.

### **DEPARTMENTAL REPORTS:**

**Water/Wastewater** Robert Burson gave the report; a copy of which is filed with these minutes.

**Streets** Mayor Arey stated there was nothing to report.

**Police** Lt. Mike Hardester gave the police report; a copy of which is filed with these minutes. At the request of Harmony Grove School, the Haskell Police Officers did a drill with the teachers in their classroom on the steps to be taken in the event any endangering situation at the School.

**Court** Mayor Arey gave the report; a copy of which is filed with these minutes.

**Planning** No report

**Code Enforcement** A listing of contacts made in November was presented. There were no comments, questions, or additions.

**Fire & Rescue** Fire Chief Brian Cotten reported that in November there were 10 rescues, 3 fire related incidents, and 73 man hours of training.

### **OLD BUSINESS** CONTINUED REVIEW OF 2014 PRELIMINARY BUDGET

Mayor Arey advised that this 2<sup>nd</sup> draft of the 2014 budget has not changed dramatically from the initial budget presented at the October meeting. This 2<sup>nd</sup> draft shows the 2013 income and expenditures through November 30, 2013.

### **DISCUSSION:**

Administration Dept "Local Property Taxes" - we are anticipating another large check for December which would reach our budgeted amount for 2013 of \$175,000.00. The amount of this check will determine if we have budgeted correctly for 2014, or if we will have to make budget cuts in other areas.

Administration Dept "Miscellaneous Expense" We have been notified that effective April 20, 2014 the accounting software that we use will no longer receive software support. We must make changes due to Microsoft software changes. The total charge for this is \$7000.00; 50% from General Fund Admin and 50% from Water/Sewer Dept.

District Court "Payroll Expense" In 2008 the Recorder/Treasurer's salary and hours were increased to fill a need in helping with processing tickets and various other duties in the Court. At Janie's request, she would now like to return to the salary and hours of the Recorder/Treasurer. An Ordinance will be presented at the January Council Meeting for this change. This will require the hiring of a part-time person.

Parks & Recreation "Repairs & Maint-Bldgs" \$6000.00 has been budget for a new roof for the Museum and new flooring for the Community Center.

Streets Income- Municipal 4 Lane HWC represents the ½ cent sales tax from the Highway Bond Fund. It is estimated that the City of Haskell will receive approximately \$70,000.00 per year for ten (10) years.

Water/Sewer "Worker's Compensation" Expenses Alderman
Ronnie Ballard noted the increase from last year's budget amount. Mayor Arey
agreed that this did not appear to be correct, and he would check into it.
Hal Baker made the motion, seconded by Ronnie Ballard, to table the budget until
the January meeting. The motion passed unanimously by yea vote.

**ANNOUNCEMENTS** The Mayor's Youth Advisory Council recently participated in the "Arkansas Drive Smart Challenge". Their campaign won for **BEST OVERALL SEAT BELT IMPROVEMENT**, winning \$100.00.

There being no further comments, questions, or announcements, the Meeting was adjourned.

She further stated that Mr. Harrison has an engineer that is doing a Base Flood Elevation study of the area he is planning to build on.
